

Minnesota Contraceptive Coverage Accommodations Reporting

DATA SUBMISSION FORM AND MANNER

MARCH 25, 2024

In 2023, the Minnesota updated requirements for contraceptive coverage with no cost sharing, with a provision for organizations that are exempt from offering coverage, and required accommodations (MN Statutes, section 62Q.522). The statute also requires reporting to the MDH on the number of organizations granted an accommodation.

Data Reporting Required – Contraceptive Coverage Accommodations

Health Plan companies are required to submit data beginning on January 1, 2024, and each year following. The data should be reported as of January 1, 2024.

What types of insurance are included?

All fully-insured comprehensive private health insurance, including small-group and large-group fully insured plans.

Who is required to report?

Any health plan company that covers Minnesota Residents with fully-insured comprehensive private health insurance.

Which organizations should reporting be done on?

Reporting should be limited to organizations which are located in Minnesota (e.g. Minnesota is the state of situs).

Where should reporting be sent?

Reporting should be sent to the regulating entity: the Department of Health for Health Maintenance Organizations, or the Department of Commerce for all other health plan companies.

Data reporting elements

- Total number of organizations granted an accommodation for coverage.
- Total number of organizations that are purchasing coverage.

How should reporting be completed?

How to submit data
