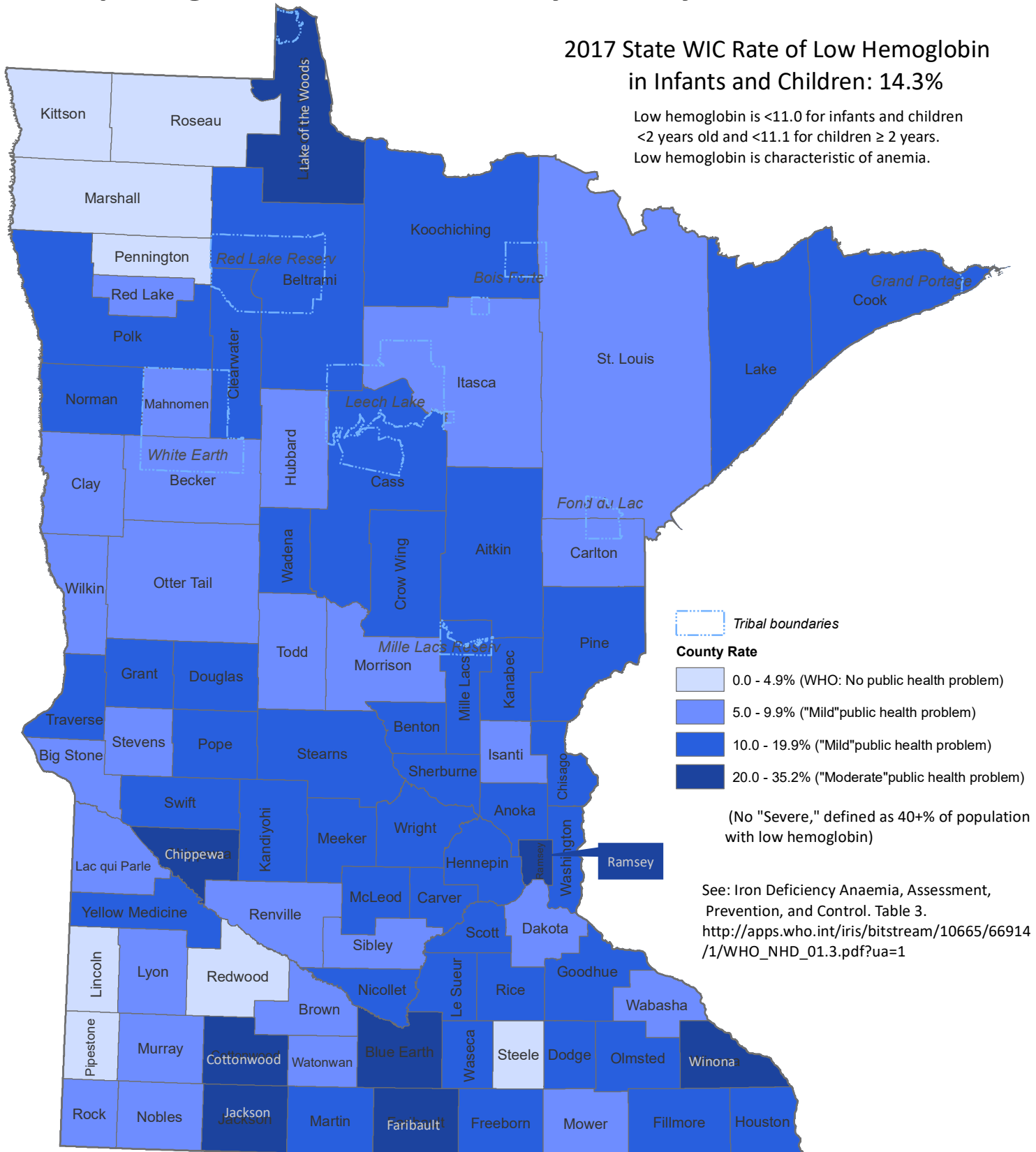


Low Hemoglobin for Infants and Children Participating in Minnesota WIC by County of Residence, 2017

2017 State WIC Rate of Low Hemoglobin
in Infants and Children: 14.3%

Low hemoglobin is <11.0 for infants and children
<2 years old and <11.1 for children ≥ 2 years.
Low hemoglobin is characteristic of anemia.
