



### Primary\* Refugee Arrivals to Minnesota by Region of World 1979-2022






# Primary Refugee Arrivals by Month Minnesota, 2018-2022







### Primary Refugee Arrivals Minnesota, 2022








#### Country of Origin by County of Resettlement, Minnesota, 2022





### Primary Refugee Arrivals Screened in Minnesota 2010 –2022






#### Primary Refugees' Reasons for No Screening, Minnesota, 2022

Hepatitis B infection***	1,772 (86%)	60 (3%)
Parasitic infection****	1,549 (75%)	255 (16%)
Sexually transmitted infections (STIs)*****	1,721 (84%)	11 (1%)
Lead*****	609 (82%)	37 (6%)
Hemoglobin	1,762 (86%)	301 (17%)




### Latent or Active Tuberculosis (TB)\* Among Refugees By Region Of Origin Minnesota, 2022





# Intestinal Parasitic Infection\* Among Refugees by Region of Origin Minnesota, 2022








# Hepatitis B\* infection Among Refugees by Region of Origin Minnesota, 2022
