For individuals and businesses interested in becoming certified** to do radon measurement and mitigation in Minnesota, the following steps should be taken:

Midwest Universities Radon Consortium (MURC) Training Courses

- Look up class schedule at http://events.cce.umn.edu/events/course_list.aspx?cluster_cd=WB27 and determine which courses you would like to take.
- Register for the course online or by calling 612-624-4754. Registration materials may also be requested by emailing cceconf3@umn.edu. The standard charge is \$395.00 for the radon measurement course and \$550.00 for the mitigation course.
- Take and pass the appropriate certification exam offered after each course. The exam schedule can be viewed at the following link: <http://www.cce.umn.edu/Radon-Courses-for-Professionals/Exam-Information/index.html>. The cost for each exam is \$150. Note that these exams are NRPP only. If you need to take the NRSB exam only skip the next two steps. Otherwise, skip the NRSB steps.

- Complete NEHA-NRPP application form found here: http://www.radongas.org/NRPP_Application_June_2007.doc. This form must be returned with the appropriate registration fee, which is generally \$150.00 for a two-year period.
- Every two years, the certification must be renewed. The current renewal fee is \$130.00 for a two-year period. In order for a renewal to be accepted, the applicant must earn an appropriate amount of continuing education credits. It is highly recommended by MDH that mitigators receive certification in order to ensure a high quality of work as well as enjoy the benefits associated with certification such as consumer confidence and proven lead-generating potential.
