308.18 Subd. 1a. **Fees for ionizing radiation-producing equipment.** (a) A facility with  
308.19 ionizing radiation-producing equipment must pay an annual initial or annual  
renewal

308.20 registration fee consisting of a base facility fee of \$66 \$100 and an additional fee  
for

308.21 each radiation source, as follows:

308.22 (1) medical or veterinary equipment \$ 53 100

308.23 (2) dental x-ray equipment \$ 33 40

308.24 (3) accelerator \$ 66

308.25 (4) radiation therapy equipment \$ 66

308.27 humans or animals

\$ 53 100

308.28 (6) (4) devices with sources of ionizing

308.31 (b) A facility with radiation therapy and accelerator equipment must pay an  
annual
