The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) completed an initial survey on December 31, 2025, for the purpose of assessing compliance with state licensing statutes. At the time of the survey MDH noted no violations of the laws pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 144A.

In addition, on December 31, 2025, evaluators of this Department's staff visited the above home and community based services (HCBS) provider and there were no correction orders issued. At the time of the evaluation, there were no active clients receiving services under the HCBS license.

The enclosed State Form documents no violations. MDH documents the state correction orders using federal software. Please disregard the heading of the fourth column that states, "Provider's Plan of Correction." A plan of correction is not required.
