Dear Administrator:

On June 13, 2025, Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) forwarded the results of the Federal Monitoring Survey (FMS) to you and informed you that your facility was not in substantial compliance with the applicable Federal requirements for nursing homes participating in the Medicare and Medicaid programs and imposed enforcement remedies.

The Minnesota Department of Health completed a Federal Monitoring revisit on July 7, 2025 to confirm that your facility had attained and maintained compliance. Based on our visit, we have determined that your facility has achieved substantial compliance.

As authorized by CMS the remedy of:

- Mandatory denial of payment for new Medicare and Medicaid admissions effective September 3, 2025 did not go into effect. (42 CFR 488.417 (b))
