On May 13, 2025, the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) completed a follow-up survey of your facility to determine correction of orders found on the survey completed on January 15, 2025. This follow-up survey determined your facility had not corrected all of the state correction orders issued pursuant to the January 15, 2025 survey.

In accordance with Minn. Stat. § 144G.31 Subd. 4 (a), state correction orders issued pursuant to the last survey, completed on January 15, 2025, found not corrected at the time of the May 13, 2025, follow-up survey and/or subject to penalty assessment are as follows:

0775-Fire Protection And Physical Environment-144g.45 Subd. 2. (a)

The details of the violations noted at the time of this follow-up survey completed on May 13, 2025 (listed above), are on the attached State Form. Brackets around the ID Prefix Tag in the left hand column, e.g., {2 ----} will identify the uncorrected tags.

The licensee failed to provide resident bedrooms with the minimum window opening meeting the minimum state standard for egress. This had the potential to affect some residents, staff, and visitors. This practice resulted in a level two violation (a violation that harmed a resident's health or safety, not including serious injury, impairment, or death, or a violation that has the potential to lead to serious injury, impairment, or death) and was issued at a pattern scope (when more than a limited number of residents are affected, more than a limited number of staff are involved, or the situation has occurred repeatedly; but is not found to be pervasive). The findings include: On May 15, 2025, at 9:00 a.m., surveyor toured the facility with licensed assisted living director (LALD)-B. Survey staff observed that the new egress bedroom windows in Resident apartment #102 and #202 had not been installed yet. During the survey the LALD-B explained to the surveyor that they were applying for a permit with Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry and could not install the windows until the proper permits are in place. The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) completed a survey on January 15, 2025, for the purpose of evaluating and assessing compliance with state licensing statutes. At the time of the survey, MDH noted violations of the laws pursuant to Minnesota Statute, Chapter 144G, Minnesota Food Code, Minnesota Rules Chapter 4626, Minnesota Statute 626.5572 and/or Minnesota Statute Chapter 260E.

STATE CORRECTION ORDERS

The enclosed State Form documents the state correction orders. MDH documents state licensing correction orders using federal software. Tag numbers are assigned to Minnesota state statutes for Assisted Living Facilities. The assigned tag number appears in the far left column entitled "ID Prefix Tag." The state statute number and the corresponding text of the state statute out of compliance are listed in the "Summary Statement of Deficiencies" column. This column also includes the findings that are in violation of the state statute after the statement, "This MN Requirement is not met as evidenced by . . ."

IMPOSITION OF FINES

In accordance with Minn. Stat. § 144G.31, Subd. 4, fines and enforcement actions may be imposed based on the level and scope of the violations and may be imposed immediately with no opportunity to correct the violation first as follows:

Level 1: no fines or enforcement.

Level 2: a fine of \$500 per violation, in addition to any enforcement mechanism authorized in § 144G.20 for widespread violations;

Level 3: a fine of \$3,000 per violation per incident, in addition to any enforcement mechanism authorized in § 144G.20.

Level 4: a fine of \$5,000 per incident, in addition to any enforcement mechanism authorized in § 144G.20.

Therefore, in accordance with Minn. Stat. §§ 144G.01 to 144G.9999, the following fines are assessed pursuant to this survey:

2310 - 144g.91 Subd. 4 (a) - Appropriate Care And Services - \$3,000.00

Therefore, in accordance with Minn. Stat. §§ 144G.01 to 144G.9999, **the total amount you are assessed is \$3,000.00**. You will be invoiced approximately 30 days after receipt of this notice, subject to appeal.

DOCUMENTATION OF ACTION TO COMPLY

In accordance with Minn. Stat. § 144G.30, Subd. 5(c), the licensee must document actions taken to comply with the correction orders within the time period outlined on the state form; however, plans of correction are not required to be submitted for approval.

The correction order documentation should include the following:

- Identify how the area(s) of noncompliance was corrected related to the resident(s)/employee(s) identified in the correction order.
- Identify how the area(s) of noncompliance was corrected for all of the provider's resident(s)/employees that may be affected by the noncompliance.
- Identify what changes to your systems and practices were made to ensure compliance with the specific statute(s).

Stat. § 144G.20, Subd. 14 and Subd. 18, a request for a hearing must be in writing and received by the Department of Health within 15 business days of the correction order receipt date. The request must contain a brief and plain statement describing each matter or issue contested and any new information you believe constitutes a defense or mitigating factor.

This MN Requirement is not met as evidenced by: Based on observation, interview, and record review, the licensee failed to ensure the care and services were provided according to acceptable health care and medical, or nursing standards for one of one resident (R1) with an assistive device (consumer bed rail). This resulted in an immediate order for correction on January 13, 2025. This practice resulted in a level three violation (a violation that harmed a resident's health or safety, not including serious injury, impairment, or death, or a violation that has the potential to lead to serious injury, impairment, or death), and was issued at a widespread scope (when problems are pervasive or represent a systemic failure that has affected or has potential to affect a large portion or all of the residents). The findings include: During a visit to R1's apartment with registered nurse (RN)-D on January 13, 2025, at 2:20 p.m., the surveyor observed R1's bed to have a consumer bed rail on the right side of the twin-sized bed. The bed rail was an upside-down U-shaped rail which was placed between the mattress and box spring. The bed rail went to the floor, and when the mattress was raised, had a bar that was square and reached approximately 3/4 of the width of the mattress. A black strap was wrapped around the two t-sections of the furthest	02310

The bed rail was a Healthcraft Smart Rail model number HC2012SRS-TW. R1 stated she had the bed for a very long time and used the bed rail to get in and out of bed and to adjust herself when in bed. R1 was admitted to the facility on May 21, 2021, with diagnoses including unspecified displaced fracture of first cervical vertebra, macular degeneration, carotid artery syndrome, and hypertension. R1's Service Plan dated December 27, 2023, noted R1 received assistance with medication management and bathing. R1's Uniform Assessment Tool on Admission dated November 19, 2024, indicated assistive devices used included a shoehorn, sock donner, and a four wheeled walker. It noted R1 wore glasses, received assistance with bathing, compression stockings, and medication management, was independent with transferring, toileting, ambulation, and mobility. The assessment noted a history of falls and vertigo, and that R1 had difficulty sleeping. On January 13, 2025, at 2:30 p.m., RN-D stated an assessment of the bedrail had not been completed for R1 because it would be a Bed Safety Assessment and R1 did not have a Bed Safety Assessment in their record. In addition, RN-D stated the manufacturer directions for use were not available and they had not referred to the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) for information related to portable bed rail recalls. 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02310	Continued From page 27 assisted living director (LALD)-B stated the maintenance staff had checked for a recall but was not sure when and the documentation had not been saved. R1's record lacked an assessment of the bed rail to include the purpose and intent of the bed rail, the condition and description of the bed rail, the resident's preferences, a physical inspection of the bed rail and mattress for areas of entrapment, stability, and correct installation, and any necessary information related to interventions to mitigate the safety risk or negotiated risk agreements. It also lacked the risk versus benefits, documentation the bed rail was installed and maintained according to the manufacturer's directions, and evidence the bed rail had been checked for a recall. The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) website, Assisted Living Resources & Frequently-Asked Questions (FAQs) last updated December 13, 2024, indicated, "To ensure an individual is an appropriate candidate for a bed rail, the licensee must assess the individual's cognitive and physical status as they pertain to the bed rail to determine the intended purpose for the bed rail and whether that person is at high risk for entrapment or falls. This may include assessment of the individual's incontinence needs, pain, uncontrolled body movement or ability to transfer in and out of bed without assistance. The licensee must also consider whether the bed rail has the effect of being an improper restraint." Also included, "Documentation about a resident's bed rails includes, but is not limited to: - Purpose and intention of the bed rail; - Condition and description (i.e., an area large enough for a resident to become entrapped) of	02310

02310	Continued From page 28 the bed rail; - The resident's bed rail use/need assessment; - Risk vs. benefits discussion (individualized to each resident's risks); - The resident's preferences; - Installation and use according to manufacturer's guidelines; - Physical inspection of bed rail and mattress for areas of entrapment, stability, and correct installation; and - Any necessary information related to interventions to mitigate safety risk or negotiated risk agreements". The MDH website, Assisted Living Resources & Frequently-Asked Questions (FAQs) also indicated "licensees should refer to individual manufacturer's guidelines for appropriate installation, maintenance and use. In addition, licensees should refer to the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CSPC) for the most up-to-date information related to portable bed side rail recall information." The FDA, "A Guide to Bed Safety" revised April 2010, included the following information: "When bed rails are used, perform an on-going assessment of the patient's physical and mental status, closely monitor high-risk patients." The FDA also identified, "Patients who have problems with memory, sleeping, incontinence, pain, uncontrolled body movement, or who get out of bed and walk unsafely without assistance, must be carefully assessed for the best ways to keep them from harm, such as falling. Assessment by the patient's health care team will help to determine how best to keep the patient safe." No further information was provided.	02310
