___ Facility has documentation of supervisory responsibility for the TB infection control program.

___ Results of baseline TB screening of all paid and unpaid healthcare workers are documented. ___ If the setting is classified as "medium risk" or higher, results of serial TB screening of all paid and unpaid healthcare workers are documented. All reports or copies of tuberculin skin tests (TSTs), IGRAs/TB blood tests for *M. tuberculosis*, medical evaluation, and chest radiograph results are maintained in the healthcare worker's employee file.

Residents (for Nursing Homes and Boarding Care Facilities only)

___ Results of baseline TB screening of all residents within 72 hours of admission or within 3 months prior to admission are documented. All reports or copies of tuberculin skin tests (TSTs), IGRAs/TB blood tests for *M. tuberculosis*, medical evaluation, and chest radiograph results are maintained in the patient's medical record.
