1. **Page 14:**

Footnote 4 should read:

Adults: “One or more days” to “During the past 12 months, how many days were you unable to work or carry out your usual activities because of your asthma?” OR responded “a little”, “moderate amount”, or “a lot” to: “During the past 12 months, would you say you limited your usual activities due to asthma not at all, a little, a moderate amount, or a lot?”

Children: “During the past 12 months, would you say your child limited your usual activities due to asthma not at all, a little, a moderate amount, or a lot?” [During the past 12 months, how many days were you unable to work or carry out your usual activities because of your asthma?” not asked in child survey.]

<sup>1</sup>“One or more” to: “During the past 30 days, on how many days did you or your child have any symptoms of asthma?”

<sup>2</sup>“One or more” to: “During the past 30 days, on how many days did symptoms of asthma make it difficult for you or your child to stay asleep?”

<sup>3</sup>“Yes” to: “During the past 12 months, have you or has your child had an episode of asthma or an asthma attack?”

<sup>4</sup>“One or more days” to: “During the past 12 months, how many days were you unable to work or carry out your usual activities because of your asthma?” [This question not asked in child survey.]

<sup>5</sup>“A little”, “a moderate amount” or “a lot” to: “During the past 12 months, would you say you or your child limited your usual activities due to asthma not at all, a little, a moderate amount, or a lot?”

<sup>6</sup>“One or more days” to “During the past 12 months, how many days were you unable to work or carry out your usual activities because of your asthma?” OR “a little”, “moderate amount”, or “a lot” to: “During the past 12 months, would you say you limited your usual activities due to asthma not at all, a little, a moderate amount, or a lot?”

<sup>7</sup>“One or more” to: “During the past 12 months, how many times did you or your child see a doctor or other health professional for urgent treatment of worsening asthma symptoms or for an asthma episode or attack?”

<sup>8</sup>“One or more” to: “During the past 12 months, how many times did you or your child visit an emergency room or urgent care center because of your asthma?”

<sup>9</sup>“One or more days” to: “During the past 12 months, about how many days of school did your child miss because of his/her asthma?”
