

Mantoux Tuberculin Skin Test Models Kits

The Minnesota Department of Health's TB Prevention and Control Program has recently developed a Mantoux Tuberculin Skin Test Models Kit. The kit is ideal for practicing the skills needed to properly read and interpret Mantoux tuberculin skin tests.

Kits are available for loan to health care providers in Minnesota and may be borrowed for up to 3 weeks. Kits will be available on a first-come first-served basis.

Kit includes:

- 2 Biolike arm models (one light and one dark) and answer key
- 2 wet-erase markers
- Container of baby powder
- *Mantoux Tuberculin Skin Test* video and facilitator guide from CDC
- Mantoux rulers
- "Positive or Negative" worksheet for photocopying and answer key
- Induration interpretation worksheet for photocopying (*Candidates for treatment of LTBI*)
- Information about purchasing Mantoux training arms
- 1 laminated Care and cleaning instructions sheet
- *Guide for Primary Health Care Providers: Targeted Tuberculin Testing and Treatment of Latent Tuberculosis Infection* from CDC
