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Suggested Steps to Help Improve Immunization Rates

Assess the immunization status of each child at every clinic visit

- Check MIIC or the child's immunization record card to see if additional shots are due. Obtain the child's immunization record from another clinic as needed.
- Remind parents to bring immunization record cards with them to each visit.

Don't miss opportunities to vaccinate!

- Give all the vaccines that are due each visit. Simultaneous administration of two or more vaccines at separate sites is safe and effective.

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- Vaccinate children whose siblings are in the office.
- Go ahead and vaccinate if a child:
 - Has a minor acute illness like a common cold with low grade fever
 - Is on antibiotics
 - Is breastfeeding
 - Has a mom who is pregnant

Set up a workable reminder/recall system

- Use MIIC's patient follow up feature to help clinics remind patients about past due or upcoming immunizations.
- Ask parents to self-address a postcard for the clinic to mail when the child's next immunization is due.
- Schedule the next immunization appointment before the end of each visit.
