PORTICO HealthNet: *For residents of Ramsey, Dakota and Washington counties who do not have insurance*, call 651-603-5100. Portico provides assistance in finding a health care program such as MinnesotaCare, MA, or GAMC. It also provides its own health access program for people without health insurance (not eligible for the above programs) including primary care, preventive care, some specialty care, eye exams, eyeglasses and prescriptions. Spanish- and Hmong- speaking staff available; interpreters provided for other languages.
