

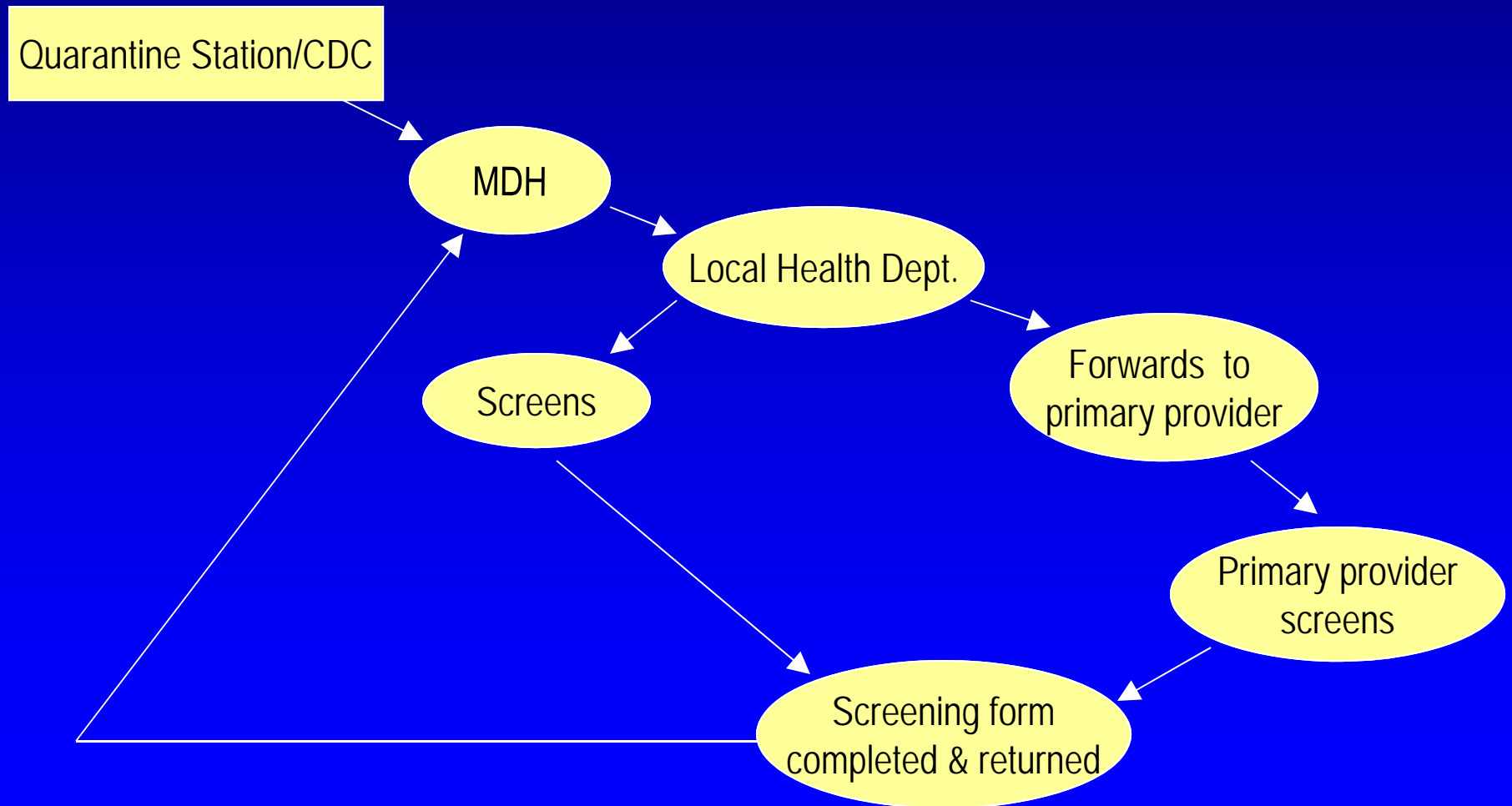

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Refugee Health Assessment Information Flow



What is "SCARD"?

ACCESS database developed to assist LPH:

- Manage clinic assignment for the domestic refugee health screening
- track referral outcomes for health conditions identified during the overseas or domestic screening.

(Hopefully minimize paper tracking)

Tracking Database Workflow

- I. Identify a screening clinic location and capacity
- II. Assign a family/individual to a screening clinic and date for screening
- III. Enter demographic information on each client
- IV. Track through completion of the screening
- V. Conduct follow-up on referrals
