Context

- MSUM established in 1885 as a normal school
- MS Teacher's college in 1921 allowed to grant first 4 year degree
- St Luke's Hospital School of Nursing—no RN-to-BSN option locally
- Large number of RNs needing BSN
- First BSN completion students admitted in 1976





Context continued

- North Dakota border
 - ND required BSN for licensure until 2004
- Articulation with Associate degree RN programs
- Initial accreditation by the NLN in 1981 and continuously held since (currently CCNE)





Nursing Students

- RN to BSN students
 - Currently licensed
 - Working
 - Families and other obligations
- Students are working and generally place bound (by family and other commitments)





Distance education

- Classes one or two days/evenings per week
- Traveling faculty: St. Cloud, Thief River Falls
- Interactive TV
- On-line:
 - Hybrid with classes and/or ITV
 - Fully on-line

- Your username is your MSUM ID number (with leading zeroes). – 8 digits
- Your password is your birthdate in the following format: yymmdd - i.e. Feb. 6, 1983 is 830206
- If your birthday is not in MSUM's student database records, the password defaults to the last six digits of your Social Security Number
- At the first login: CHANGE YOUR PASSWORD in the My Password settings on the main D2L page. When you change your password (6 digits or more) remember that the password is case sensitive and special characters (: ? / & * , etc) should not be used.
