The MDH Environmental Laboratory provides analytical services primarily for government agencies and selected lake associations. To inquire about establishing an account, please contact the Environmental Laboratory Operations Unit at (651) 201-5300.

Private citizens who are seeking analytical services are encouraged to contact their county health agency for access to lab services. Water testing services for private well owners are available from both county health agencies and private laboratories throughout the state. Testing of well water should be performed only by a laboratory accredited by MDH to perform the requested tests.
