Successful Utilization of EHRs: How Can the ARRA Support Ongoing Efforts

The Minnesota Department of Health's Division of Health Policy is responsible for programs that: monitor and track health care access, cost, and quality; implement Minnesota's current health reform efforts; promote the adoption and use of interoperable electronic health records; implement administrative simplification efforts; monitor and report on adverse health events; promote access to quality health care for rural and underserved urban Minnesotans through the Office of Rural Health and Primary Care; administer the Medical Education and Research Cost fund to support medical education activities in Minnesota; and maintain the official, permanent state birth and death records for Minnesota.

George Gerlach, Board Chair, Minnesota Hospital Association

The MHA represents 149 hospitals and 17 health systems in Minnesota. These range from Critical Access Hospitals with fewer than 25 inpatient beds to major urban teaching centers. Because of this wide spectrum, hospitals face a varying and diverse set of issues regarding health information technology.

The Minnesota Medical Association is a professional association representing physicians, residents, and medical students, working together for a healthy Minnesota. With more than 11,000 members, the MMA is a powerful advocate on health care issues at the State Capitol and in Washington D.C.
