



Baskets of Care Early Adopters Summit

The concept of Baskets of Care was included in the 2008 Minnesota health reform legislation. The concept seeks to bundle payments for a set of health care services to create incentives for relevant health care providers to collaborate and develop innovative ways to deliver effective, high-quality and lower cost health care services. The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) is committed to the community-driven nature of the baskets of care development process and has contracted with the Institute for Clinical Systems Improvement (ICSI) to facilitate this process. Since January 2009, much work has been done to define the baskets of care, determine how to measure their outcomes, and identify and propose solutions to operational and administrative challenges to implementing the baskets of care.

On behalf of MDH, ICSI will be facilitating a Baskets of Care Summit for health care delivery organizations, health plans, and other stakeholders that are considering becoming early adopters of one or more of the baskets of care.

During the Summit, attendees will learn about the eight developed baskets of care, will be able to discuss identified challenges and proposed solutions on operational and administrative issues involved with setting up a basket of care, and will have an opportunity to network and share ideas with other early adopters of the baskets of care.
