## **1. Broken Trusts, Broken Childhoods, February 24, 2007, 8:00 p.m.**

The Sexual Abuse Prevention Network, a national organization committed to the prevention of childhood sexual abuse throughout the United States, in partnership with Twin Cities Public Television (TPT) has produced a moving documentary about childhood sexual abuse within the school system.

The program addresses a pervasive problem in American society. It is also about hope - hope for survivors, their families, and our children. Portions of the program are from a panel discussion held in Bloomington, MN in December 2006 keynoted by national expert Carol Shakeshaft, Ph.D. of Hofstra University interspersed with interviews of three survivors and the mother of a victim.

Please tune into the premier airing of the program on TPT Channel 17 on Saturday, February 24, at 8:00 p.m. (CST) right after Almanac. If you live outside of the TPT viewing area, contact your local public television station and ask them to broadcast the program. The program is being uplinked for other public television stations throughout the country.
