# Grantee Responsibilities

---

---

- ★ Develop and submit and evaluation plan within the first six months of grant
- ★ Conduct program evaluation
- ★ Collect, analyze, and report evaluation data
- ★ Evaluation funds
  - Set aside 10% of implementation funds
- ★ Attend in-state evaluation training and technical assistance events

# MDH Responsibilities

- ★ Provide technical assistance
- ★ Collect and manage evaluation data
- ★ Track statewide trends
- ★ Report to stakeholders
  - Legislative report
  - Ongoing sharing of results with other key stakeholders
