STAC Vacancies Open for Appointment

Applications are being accepted November 1 for seven positions open January 2011. Each position is a four-year term.

Emergency Medicine Physician

Qualifications: An emergency physician certified by the American Board of Emergency Medicine or the American Osteopathic Board of Emergency Medicine whose practice includes emergency room care in a level I, II, III or IV trauma hospital.

Rural Family Practice Physician

Qualifications: A physician certified by the American Board of Family Medicine or the American Osteopathic Board of Family Practice whose practice includes emergency department care in a level I, II, III or IV trauma hospital located in a designated rural area as defined under section 144.1501, subdivision 1, paragraph (b).

Rural EMS Attendant or Ambulance Director

Qualifications: An attendant or ambulance director who is an EMT, EMT-I or EMT-P within the meaning of section 144E.001 and who actively practices with a licensed ambulance service area located in a designated rural area as defined under section 144.1501, subdivision 1, paragraph (b).

Pediatrician

Qualifications: A pediatrician certified by the American Board of Pediatrics or the American Osteopathic Board of Pediatrics whose practice includes emergency department care in a level I, II, III or IV trauma hospital.

Orthopedic Surgeon

Qualifications: An orthopedic surgeon certified by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery or the American Osteopathic Board of Orthopedic Surgery whose practice includes trauma and who practices in a level I, II, III or IV trauma hospital.

Level I or II Trauma Program Manager

Qualifications: A trauma program nurse manager or coordinator practicing in a level I or II trauma hospital.

Rehabilitation Specialist

Qualifications: A rehabilitation specialist whose practice includes rehabilitation of patients with major trauma injuries or traumatic brain injuries and spinal cord injuries as defined under section 144.661.
