Step 1: Search the Registry

The Minnesota Nurse Aide Registry is located at:

- Click the **Search Certificate** button in the top left of the window to open the search page.
- Enter information about the Nurse Aide you are searching for:
 - First name, last name, and last four digits of their social security number, or
 - Search by certificate number
- Click the blue **Search** building in the bottom left to show the search results.

Step 2: Results

This website is considered **primary source verification**. The registry information on the website is real time with the registry database.
