Initial Applicants

Effective August 3, 2020, initial health facility licensing/registration applications received April 8, 2020 and after will be processed in order received and checks will be cashed unless payment was previously processed.

Renewals

Effective August 3, 2020, renewal applications received at MDH April 8, 2020 or after will be processed in order received and checks will be cashed unless payment was previously processed.

Based on available resources, MDH will send via U.S. Mail notices for renewal applications as we have done in the past. These notices will include renewal applications for those that have not been sent by MDH to date and for upcoming renewals.
