



Mercy Hospital - Unity Campus Fast Facts

- 71 Inpatient beds for adults and seniors.
- The campus includes:
 - Emergency Department staffed 24/7 with Mental Health Crisis Clinicians and E.D Psychiatry
 - Center for Mental Health and Addiction
 - Adult/Senior Intensive Outpatient Addiction services
 - Scheduled and walk-in chemical dependency evaluations
 - Virtual addiction clinic serving Minnesota and Western Wisconsin.
 - Hospital-Based Clinc serving children, adolescents, adults and seniors
 - Partial Hospital and Day Treatment.





Why the inpatient chemical dependency unit is closing

- Advances in addiction medicine now allow many patients to access these services on an outpatient basis or through general admission.
- This has led to fewer patients in the specialized unit.




Continued access to Mental Health and Addiction Services

- Patients can continue to get the addiction care they need in an outpatient setting at several locations, including the Center for Mental Health and Addiction Care on the Unity Campus and virtually.
- We are expanding access to outpatient addiction services at additional locations in 2026.

Outpatient addiction services	 Center for Mental Health and Addiction Care (Unity Campus) United Hospital – Hastings Regina Campus Cambridge Medical Center Virtual
Medical Detox	Available through general admission.

Update on our Kidney Transplant Program

- The Kidney Transplant and Living Kidney
 Donor Program has operated at Abbott
 Northwestern Hospital for 28 years
- The program has cared for patients in need of a new kidney from the moment they join the waiting list through recovery, including lifelong post-transplant care. The program has also cared for living kidney donors.
- As of June 27, 2025, we no longer perform kidney transplants.



Update on our Kidney Transplant Program

 Why? We made this decision after careful consideration of our ability to fully staff the program.

What's NOT changing?

- Patients have not lost accumulated waiting time. Current wait times are preserved and can be transferred
 once they are approved by another kidney transplant center.
- Eligible patients are still on the national kidney transplant waitlist.

Continued care for transplant patients

- We continue to care for patients who have had a kidney transplant.
- We are working closely with patients who were awaiting transplant to transfer their records to another program.

Commitment to our teams

 We are committed to working with care team members on a 1:1 basis, as well as following the process outlined with their union representatives to identify open positions if they are interested.




