

Promising Practices Home Visiting – Program Overview

The Promising Practices Home Visiting (PPHV) program will provide support for organizations to deliver community-driven non-model home visiting services to priority populations. This grant program will be flexible and allow for adaptability in response to the needs of families enrolled in the program. Applicants will describe the populations and geographic areas to be served, and approaches to provide home visiting services for hard-to-reach families. Applicants are not allowed to expand their target caseload for an existing evidence-based home visiting (EBHV) program.

Application deadline

Application deadline for this RFP is Friday, February 24, 2023, by 5 p.m. (CST)

When will funds be awarded?

Successful PPHV applicants will be notified of their grant award in April 2023. PPHV grantees will be awarded funding for a two-year grant period from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025.

Who can apply?

Applicants are advised to carefully review the eligibility requirements in the RFP before starting an online application on the [Family Home Visiting Funding and Grants Management](https://www.health.state.mn.us/communities/fhv/grant.html) (<https://www.health.state.mn.us/communities/fhv/grant.html>) web page.

Grant range

Applicants may request between \$100,000 - \$250,000 per year in PPHV funding. No cash match is required.

Informational Sessions

Applicants are encouraged to attend online informational sessions to ask questions about the grant program. This may include questions about the review criteria, writing the narrative, budgets/allowable costs, or any other programmatic or budget questions. All sessions are drop-in format and will be offered virtually via MS Teams.

Applicants are required to use the grant interface portal, [Foundant](#) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=mdcfh>) to submit the LOI and application materials.

Interested applicants must submit a Letter of Intent (LOI) for the PPHV program **by Friday, January 27, 2023**. Application documents must be submitted in Foundant no later than 5 p.m. (CST) **on Friday, February 24, 2023**.
