

## Module 2: Activity 4

### ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

#### Purpose

To help make connections between the social-ecological model and the Statewide Health Assessment (SHA). The social-ecological model has 5 levels: individual, interpersonal, institutional, community, and policy. The purpose of the assignment is for you to connect the information provided in the readings and lectures on environmental health and the levels into the social-ecological model.

#### Task

1. Read and listen to all assigned readings and lectures given about the SHA
2. Review the social-ecological model
3. Using the social-ecological model, search for environmental health examples in the SHA and lecture which demonstrate environmental impacts on a person's health. Please look for one example that is individual focused, one example interpersonal, one example institutional, one example which is community focused, and one example systems focused.

#### Criteria

For each example based on the **belonging** section of the SHA provide 1-3 sentences description of how you see if it is impacting individual/interpersonal/institutional/community/or policy.
