Public health system consultants at the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) offer consultation and technical assistance to governmental public health system partners to promote and maintain a strong public health infrastructure. The Tribal public health system consultant supports Tribal public health capacity development to ensure a strong public health system in Tribal nations across Minnesota.

The Tribal public health system consultant works with tribal public health leaders in each Tribal Nation to customize support and technical assistance in the following areas:

- Orientation of new leaders to Minnesota's public health system
- Strategic planning
- Workforce development planning
- Tribal public health accreditation support
- Navigation of MDH public health programs

The MDH system consultants' team builds supportive relationships with system partners by meeting regularly, assessing needs, providing support, addressing tensions/conflicts, and facilitating communications and connections with MDH programs and subject matter experts. The Tribal public health system consultant works closely with the Office of American Indian Health at MDH.
