## **Electronic System for the Health Assessment of Refugees**

ew, web-based application designed by the Refugee Health Program for collecting  $\mathbf{V}$  refugee health screening results and conducting disease surveillance activities.

## SHARE allows users to:

- \* Electronically view notifications of new refugee arrivals.
- \* Directly submit domestic health screening results – moving to a paperless reporting system.
- \* Access demographic and health summary reports by county or the state as a whole.
- \* Work with a unique, user-friendly electronic surveillance tool.
- \* Enhance capacity in Minnesota for conducting timely disease surveillance.
