STAR students get active in Carver County

Steps Toward Adult Responsibility (STAR) is a post high school special education transition program available to students of Eastern Carver County Schools. STAR supports students with the transition to adult life.

In 2017, the STAR school wellness committee was inspired during presentations given by school representatives at the District Health Council and Carver County Statewide Health Improvement Partnership (SHIP) staff to increase physical activity, noting that students' activity levels were highly variable.

In 2018, STAR developed an initiative to incorporate movement into the classroom by changing the structure of the school day. This change increased the number of minutes that all students engage in physical activity. SHIP provided support for the systems change and funding for equipment.

Before the change, there were no structured physical activity opportunities during the school day. Now, paraprofessional staff lead weekly, scheduled circuit stations for all students. Activities include jumping rope, step climbing, hand weights and more, and all activities are adaptable to accommodate physical and cognitive needs. Since the start of the program, 75 percent of STAR students have added an hour of weekly physical activity during the school day.

STAR staff member Shelli Sutherland noted that "without SHIP funding and support, the opportunity for physical activity would not have been successful. The variety of equipment at the circuits accommodates all students with a wide range of motor and cognitive abilities. SHIP supports our continued efforts to engage in physical activity as a lifelong skill."
