Making Saint Paul public housing a smoke-free community

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development passed a law mandating that all public housing agencies implement smoke-free policies in and around their facilities by July 30, 2018.

Initially, the idea of implementing the policy seemed daunting as Saint Paul Public Housing Agency (PHA) houses more than 10,000 residents. Through a partnership with Saint Paul-Ramsey County SHIP, Saint Paul PHA engaged in a two-year partnership with the American Lung Association (ALA) and other community partners to prepare for this change.

Saint Paul PHA received funding and support from SHIP to plan and implement the new smoke-free policy, including planning and educational meetings with senior management, staff and residents; and the creation of communication materials and signage. In addition, ALA provided cessation training to partnering organizations that serve multilingual residents from the Latino, Hmong, Karen and East African communities. ALA coordinated with partners to provide quit smoking outreach to residents, including a Freedom from Smoking clinic.

Many residents who were angry, frightened and defiant at the start, now welcome the change. Due to the changes, many residents are now more aware of the harmful impacts of smoking. Some residents were able to quit smoking altogether.

The SHIP funds directly supported this two-year long effort and improved the health of thousands of at-risk adults and children and going tobacco-free decreases health care costs and long term chronic disease burden.

Additionally, there will be a decrease of maintenance costs for building upkeep and management within Saint Paul PHA. Thanks to SHIP, a long-term plan will provide a healthy environment and holistic approach to make implementing a smoke-free environment a success.
