Connecting residents to neighborhood assets

Early in 2017, Saint Paul's Union Park District, which covers the neighborhood where the new Minnesota United Soccer Stadium is located, approached Saint Paul-Ramsey Public Health to partner on ways to improve some challenges around the Aldine Street Pedestrian Bridge, such as poor visibility and lack of signage.

The bridge, which covers I-94 and connects the Hamline Midway and Merriam Park East neighborhoods in Saint Paul, was not a well-known transportation option among neighborhood residents.

SHIP came to the table to support improving access to physical activity in the area and connect residents to assets in their neighborhood. One solution was to purchase wayfinding signs to lead people to the pedestrian bridge. Another effort raised the profile of the bridge through a community event in July 2017, which helped neighbors know this bridge was there for them to use as a venue for walking, biking and more.

As a result of the Aldine Street Pedestrian Bridge improvements and engagement, more than 100 community members participated in the community event. The wayfinding signs resulted in informal observations of increased use of the bridge by people who walk or bike.

For example, a family living 5 minutes north of Aldine Park – located near the bridge - walks weekly across the bridge to enjoy the park, something they did not even know existed until the community event.

Planners expect that the Aldine Street Pedestrian Bridge will have increased use as it will be the preferred pedestrian and bicycle route as nearby Snelling Avenue becomes more congested with traffic once the new soccer stadium opens.


