Expanding healthy food access in Hoffman

Like many Minnesotans living in rural communities, those in Grant and Traverse Counties often drive more than 10 miles to reach a grocery store where they can purchase fresh, healthy food for their families. Such areas are classified as food deserts and their residents often lack reliable access to healthy, affordable food.

Darrel's Full Service Foods is located in Hoffman, Minn., a town of 650 people in Grant County. When Darrel and Leslie Nehk opened the store in 2012, their goals for the store were to provide adequate food to the community, especially the elderly; provide a healthy environment for local people to gather; and provide fresh fruits and vegetables, dairy and meat to local residents.

In collaboration with the Horizon Statewide Health Improvement Partnership (SHIP) team, they have made significant changes to the selection of healthy food available at their store. Just one year ago they stocked 16 varieties of fresh fruits and vegetables; now, the store carries 22 to 25 varieties at any given time. Other healthier food choices have also grown, including frozen fruits and vegetables, whole grain options, and healthy snacks near the checkout area.

Recently, SHIP staff has helped the store apply for and win a grant available to help with the purchase of an open display cooler for the front of their store. With the cooler, fresh and healthy convenience items will become available – fruit cups, healthy beverages, ready-to-go salads, wraps, sandwiches and more.

The Nehks plan to continue to add healthy options. Says Darrel, "We have recently partnered with a local grower and we are excited to sell more fresh and organic fruits and vegetables."


