Building healthy pathways for youth at Minnesota's first bicycle playground

Rochester is proud to be designated as a Bike Friendly Community with its 85 miles of paved trails, growing bicycle infrastructure and community advocacy to support bike share programs, bike friendly businesses, social cycling groups, and bicycle clubs and education for kids.

Since 2009, Olmsted County's Statewide Health Improvement Partnership (SHIP) has been instrumental throughout the planning and implementation process, including building bike infrastructure, improving access, and addressing equity through bikes and bike education.

June 4, 2018, marked the kickoff of Minnesota's first Bicycle Playground in Rochester. Over 700 hours of volunteer time were donated to turn an unused tennis court into a painted streetscape for children and their families to practice bicycle safety skills to prepare them for everyday riding situations.

Improving access to physical activity and emphasizing the importance of creating safe spaces for biking, was the impetus for creating Rochester's Bicycle Playground. The playground provides children with opportunities to learn bicycle safety in a safe environment and hone their bike riding skills.

Through collaborative partnerships with the Rochester Police Department Cops and Kids Program, Rochester Parks and Recreation, the Rochester Public Library, the Rochester Farmer's Market, Scouts and Community Education, several youth bicycle safety classes were held during the summer. The classes taught youth bike safety skills, while providing bikes to youth in need. Youth were also encouraged to eat healthy food through bike-to-market promotional events.

While childhood obesity remains a complex issue, creating environments like the Bicycle Playground go a long way toward helping children stay active.
