The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) monitors health care expenditures by collecting data from health plan companies, including commercial insurers, HMOs and other payers. Companies that are licensed to write health insurance for Minnesota residents must submit the annual Health Plan Financial and Statistical Report (HPFSR) to MDH, as required under Minnesota Statutes, Section 62J.38.

The 2021 HPFSR is due to MDH on or before **April 1, 2022**. The 2021 HPFSR reporting form, report instructions and new upload process instructions are on the [MDH website](http://www.health.state.mn.us/hpfsr) at [www.health.state.mn.us/hpfsr](http://www.health.state.mn.us/hpfsr). The 2021 HPFSR must be filed electronically by uploading the completed HPFSR Excel spreadsheet file (with any additional attachments) to <https://hepdataportalui.web.health.state.mn.us>. **Do not** encrypt or password protect your file.

If your health plan company does not currently write health insurance for Minnesota residents, please complete sections one through three of the report and follow submission instructions provided on the [MDH website](http://www.health.state.mn.us/hpfsr) at [www.health.state.mn.us/hpfsr](http://www.health.state.mn.us/hpfsr).
