Dear Mr. LeLoup,

As you know, on August 14, 2023, the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) issued a *State Register* notice to assess if another health care organization had a competing interest in the project for which you submitted a letter of intent to Commissioner Cunningham on August 1, 2023. In the 30 days since the posting, MDH has <u>not</u> received any responses to the notice.

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 144.553, this letter is to notify you that if Allina Health and its partner remain interested in moving forward with this project, Allina Health must submit a plan consistent with the requirements under Minnesota Statutes 144.552 for the purposes of MDH conducting a public interest review.
