I am concerned that Nobis intends only to serve our community for their inpatient

community services and recreation, vocational rehab, and research. Courage Kenny Rehabilitation Institute (CKRI) and other rehabilitation organizations in Minnesota are

committed to providing the continuum of services to all patients, not just the profitable parts. Additionally, I am concerned that Nobis will be inclined to choose the most profitable patients, leaving the uninsured and underinsured insured patients to the other inpatient rehab facilities. CKRI, Allina, and other health systems in the Twin Cities are committed to research and education. I see no intention by Nobis to contribute to research or education. If our current Twin Cities community of rehabilitation providers lose inpatient rehabilitation business to Nobis, the other rehabilitation organizations in the Twin Cities will lose money and be less able to provide the other essential rehabilitation services. This would be a detriment to our community as a whole, as Minnesota is known around the country for providing excellent rehabilitation care to all patients.
