

Protect Your Child from COVID-19

The COVID-19 Pfizer Vaccine is now available to children 5 to 11 years old.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends children who are able, get vaccinated.

Even children can get COVID-19, and the vaccine helps provide protection to keep children healthy.

COVID-19 vaccine is safe, free, and effective for children.

The Pfizer vaccine for children age 5-11 is a smaller dose of vaccine than the Pfizer vaccine for people age 12 and older.

The smaller dose is packaged differently, so you will want to go to a vaccine location that has this vaccine.

COVID-19 vaccine does not cause illness.

COVID-19 vaccine protects families from COVID-19.

Your child will need two doses of COVID-19 vaccine to be fully protected.

Wait 3 weeks between getting the first and second dose.

Your child is fully protected two weeks after the second dose.
