Question: Can you provide additional detail on the expectations and scale of the one-year testing, outreach, and education project which will provide point-of-care hepatitis testing and treatment referral, including follow up with individuals who do not connect to care? How many patients or sites are expected to be included?

Answer: The one-year testing, outreach, and education project will be conducted in partnership with Hennepin County Public Health. The recipient of the Project ECHO grant will work with local public health partners to identify a specific and achievable number of patients and/or sites to perform testing and treatment referral, in addition to delineating appropriate roles for each agency. All testing, outreach, and education will be limited to sites within Hennepin County and will focus on populations most at risk for hepatitis C.

Question: Where do letter of commitments go in the RFP? Do we submit an appendix or can it part of the written proposal?

Answer: The letter of commitment can be submitted as part of the written proposal or included as an appendix to the application.
