## **Receipt of Specimens and Lab Testing at MDH-PHL:**

MDH-PHL will be closed for most routine infectious disease testing for the Thanksgiving Holiday on Thursday (11/27) and Friday (11/28), with the following exceptions:

- The MDH-PHL Specimen Receiving lab will be open to receive samples on Friday (11/28) and Saturday (11/29) from 8:00 am-12:00 pm.
- The TB Lab will process specimens and report smear results on Friday (11/28).
- The MDH newborn screening laboratory staff will perform testing on Friday (11/28) and Saturday (11/29).

If your Microbiology laboratory needs urgent Infectious Disease testing, call the on-call phone 24/7 at 612-282-3723. For questions about newborn screening, contact the on-call genetic counselor at 651-201-3548.

Facilities that rely on UPS or FedEx to send samples to MDH: there will be no routine pick up or delivery on Thursday (11/27). Normal pickup and delivery will resume Friday (11/28).
