Abbott Laboratories changes PediaSure with Fiber packaging

Abbott Laboratories is changing packaging of PediaSure Grow & Gain with Fiber back to **8 oz** containers in six-count packs.

PediaSure Grow and Gain with Fiber

Hubert/Winnie food item description: PediaSure Grow & Gain with Fiber (containers)

Benefit description: container(s) RTF PediaSure Grow & Gain with Fiber

Max containers: 108 containers; six-pack will remove six containers

Currently only vanilla flavor is in the market. The UPC has been added to the APL. *REMEMBER* to issue in quantities divisible by 6 to avoid unused containers, 6-packs will not be broken for a grocery item.

How can local agencies help

- Let families know of the package changes.
- Issue in even numbers to use as much of the benefit as possible. Discuss the package count for the number of bottles/containers.
 - Example, 18 six-packs equal the max 108 containers.
 - A six-pack removes six containers.
- Reach out to your State Consultant if there are questions issuing the containers. Call the Help Desk if there are questions about issuance.
