Other Program Updates

Birth Outcomes Tableau Workbook – Joni and Marcia

Overview of the project converting WIC data reports to interactive dashboards using Tableau. Users are encouraged to try out the functionality of the new dashboards. Clicking on graphs and maps will filter data, as will selecting from drop-down menus, to narrow the data to just what you're looking for. Tableau has options for downloading the filtered data as a file, pdf or Powerpoint slide. Most of the breastfeeding data is now available and next to be posted will be birth outcomes data such as low birth weight and preterm births. Check it out by going to the <u>WIC Reports & Data</u> page – the link is on the left toolbar on all the WIC pages – and look for 'Interactive Data'.

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Waivers-Rebecca

With the expiration of COVID-19 related waivers on August 9, 2023, and implementation of the ARPA waivers on August 10, we wanted to give a reminder where resources are located on the website. The ARPA Guidance document, Q & A document, and other materials are located on the <u>WIC Local Agencies</u> - MN Dept. of Health page, under 'What You Need to Know'.

We also wanted to give a Reminder about upcoming HuBERT changes related to the ARPA waivers that will be completed on Saturday August 5.

Three changes in HuBERT:

1. For Physical Presence, Reason not present.

Add two reasons:

- Referral Data Used
- Measurements Deferred
- 2. For Bloodwork, Reason not collected.

Add one reason:

Measurements Deferred

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3. Make all the COVID-19 reasons inactive.

Changes are made on weekends when there is no clinic, and these changes need to occur before the August 10 implementation of ARPA waivers.

If the COVID related waiver is used on August 7-9, staff will need to use the "other" dropdown selection and write a note explaining the COVID related waiver used.

We provided a review of what version of the Nondiscrimination Statement (NDS) to use and when. Please see Minnesota Operation Manual Section 1.10: Civil Rights for details.

DocuSign Pilot - Rebecca

- We are currently piloting Docusign as a platform to collect signatures with two agencies. Pilot has been going well, and their feedback has been positive. The agencies shared:
 - o DocuSign is straightforward to use, and participants have found it very easy.
 - Have the document ready to send at the beginning of the appointment and send during the appointment, then you can walk the participant through how to sign. The agencies have seen better success obtaining signatures if they send the document while on the phone with the participant.
- Nest Steps: State WIC will provide access to DocuSign for all agencies to use for various documents like the Rights & Responsibilities, Primary Cardholder Signature Register, and the MDH Release of Information in English and Spanish, MOM policy, Exhibit 1-C. Agencies can add agency-specific documents, such as their Release of Information.
- WIC coordinators can request access to DocuSign for WIC staff beginning July 26. The WIC
 Information User Requests form, which is used to request WIC user access changes, will have a
 DocuSign option added. Use this form to request or remove DocuSign access for staff. For
 multiple staff, please send an Excel file with the names and email addresses of staff members to
 your State WIC Consultant.
 - o If your staff already have access to DocuSign through your agency, they are still able to have an account through MDH WIC.
- After a coordinator requests DocuSign access, an account will be created, and WIC staff will
 receive an email from the DocuSign system to activate the account. We anticipate having
 accounts created within eight business days at initial roll out.
- A guidance document for DocuSign, which will include links to DocuSign trainings, screenshots showing how to use DocuSign, and tips on using DocuSign, will be in the July 26 weekly update.

WIC Coordinators should be receiving an email from their Nutrition consultant reminding them of where they can get their current caseload count and to contact them if they want to determine if they will receiving additional funding with the closeout reallocation.

When running the Year-to-Date Participation reports out of HuBERT or Infoview, the closed-out months of October 2023 to April 2023 will only be available on the WIC Website in the Monthly Participation section. Beginning with May you can use those reports for counts of May 2023 and after. The reports posted to the website will have the numbers manually added but the close out averages will not be updated until September 2023 is closed out.
