For Cook county we are unable to locate any commercial insurance plan servicing providers for this specialty. Each of the counties that this waiver is in request for has a Chemical Dependency Outpatient facility whose radius reaches into the counties, but not all portions of these counties are fully covered by the 60 mile radius requirement due to both the varied geography of the service area & the lack of provider presence in the county.
