This application is for applying for a reciprocal license subject to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, section 149A.30 (https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/cite/149A.30). In addition to the documents below, the Minnesota mortuary science state licensing examination will need to be taken and passed prior to being issued a license.
