Instructions and Requirements

- 1. Complete and submit this form with required information to receive paid feeding assistant curriculum approval.
- 2. Submit the completed form to Health.NAR.coord@state.mn.us.
- 3. Submit an online copy of the curriculum, provide a login and password if needed.
- 4. Paid Feeding Assistant Curriculum must meet minimum requirements according to Federal regulation

 42 CFR 483.160 -- Requirements for training of paid feeding assistants which requires the training course be approved by the Minnesota Department of Health and other applicable laws.
- 5. Consistent with Minnesota Nurse Practice Act, Minnesota Statutes, section 148.17, subdivision 15 the paid feeding assistant training course must be taught by a Registered Nurse.
- 6. The paid feeding assistants must be under the supervision of registered nurse or licensed practical nurse. The facility must ensure successful completion of the course.
- 7. A written test and competency test for eating assistance must be included in the training course. The written test must be passed with a minimum of 75% on each unit quiz.

Curriculum Requirements

Minimum training course contents. A State-approved training course for paid feeding assistants must include, at a minimum, 8 hours of training in the following:

•	Feeding techniques	
•	Assistance with feeding and hydration	

Communication and interpersonal skills
Appropriate responses to resident behavior
Safety and emergency procedures, including abdominal thrusts
Infection control
Resident rights
Recognizing changes in residents that are inconsistent with their normal behavior and the
importance of reporting those changes to the supervisory nurse
A facility must maintain a record of all individuals, used by the facility as feeding assistants, who have
successfully completed the training course for paid feeding assistants
