Combined Resident Bill of Rights

An updated Combined Nursing Homes and Boarding Care Homes Bill of Rights dated November 28, 2016 is posted on the MDH website below. This new and updated version is consistent with the November 28, 2016 federal revisions related to nursing home regulatory rights. These federal changes are effective November 28, 2016.

Please use the Combined Bill of Rights for Nursing Homes and Boarding Care Homes version dated November 28, 2016 for all new admissions November 28, 2016 and after. All residents admitted prior to November 28, 2016 must receive the November 28, 2016 version by February 28, 2017.

The previous Resident Bill of Rights (Nursing Homes) will be obsolete on March 1, 2017.

Life Safety Code

For new or remodeled federally certified SNF/NFs requirements: a sink and toilet for each room, each bedroom can have a maximum of 2 individuals and bedrooms cannot share toilet rooms.

Federal Reportability Requirements

For federal reportability requirements, nursing homes federally certified must follow the revised federal nursing home regulations effective November 28, 2016.

The following two MDH Information Bulletins related to reportability are obsolete due to their inconsistency with the revised federal nursing home regulations effective November 28, 2016.

The two MDH bulletins that are obsolete are:
