

Dementia Care Training for Home Care Staff Providing Home Care Services in a Housing With Services Establishment with Assisted Living Services – Optional Form

Dementia Care Training for Home Care Staff who supervise or provide direct care in a:

- 1) Housing with Services (HSW) establishment that provides assisted living services under Minnesota Statutes 144G; and NOT under 2 or 3 below
- 2) HWS establishment with a special program or special care unit for residents with Alzheimer’s disease or other dementias; and/or
- 3) HWS that advertise, market or otherwise promote the establishment as providing services for persons with Alzheimer’s disease or other dementias, whether in a segregated or general unit.
