

FY27 International Medical Graduate (IMG) Career Guidance and Support Program Questions and Answers

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To submit a question, please email MN_Health.IMG@state.mn.us no later than 4:30 p.m. Central Time on September 11, 2026.

Q1. If an applicant wished to submit a collaborative proposal among multiple organizations, what steps would they need to take? Could an award amount exceed \$400,000 for a collaborative proposal?

A1. A collaborative application has one organization as the applicant entity with which MDH will contract. That entity provides all the necessary organizational information for contracting, such as a SWIFT ID. The proposal itself must clearly delineate roles and responsibilities for each collaborator. The anticipated maximum award amount is \$400,000, including for collaborative proposals.

Q2. Does the project start date need to be December 1, 2026?

A2. The start date of December 1, 2026 is prospective and may be subject to change based on the needs of MDH and the selected grantee(s). Applicants should use this start date when creating their work plans.

Q3. When will the next opportunity to apply for this program?

A3. FY 29 IMG Career Guidance and Support Services Grant application is anticipated to open in Summer of 2028.
