What to do

Request your record from MIIC:

- The Minnesota Immunization Information Connection (MIIC) is an immunization information system that combines a person's immunizations into a single record, even if they were given by different health care providers in Minnesota.
- To request a MIIC record, go to **Minnesota Department of Health**

Check other sources:

- Places where immunizations were given, such as a primary care clinic
- Family records, such as baby books
- School and/or child care records
- Immunization information systems in other states
- Military records

If you can't find your or your child's record, talk to a health care provider to make a plan.

What to know

Immunization records are important for you and your family

Immunization records help make sure you and your family get the right immunizations at the right time. They also are used to help meet child care, school, travel, employment, and other immunization requirements.

Immunizations keep us healthy.

Being up-to-date on all recommended immunizations helps protect you from dangerous diseases. Getting immunized also protects others who may not be able to get immunized because of a medical condition or a weakened immune system.
