

# Vulnerable Adults Suspect abuse?



*Are you concerned about abuse, neglect, or maltreatment of an older or vulnerable adult? Please contact the Minnesota Adult Abuse Reporting Center.*

## What to do

- Report suspected maltreatment of a vulnerable adult to the Minnesota Adult Abuse Reporting Center at 1-844-880-1574. It is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
- If you are reporting an emergency that requires immediate assistance from an ambulance, the police, or the fire department, call 911 first then call the reporting center.

# What to know

Reports are reviewed to see if immediate protective services are needed.

Reports of an alleged crime are referred to law enforcement. All reports of suspected maltreatment are also referred to a lead investigative agency, which may be the county or the state departments of health or human services.

Reports are confidential.
