PREP Grantee Success Stories



MN PREP provided funding to six different non-profit, community-based, youthserving organizations throughout Minnesota for five years (2018-2022).

3 in 4 participants were part of an underserved target population.

4,000

Over 4,000 participants were reached in PREP programming from 2018-2022.



After completing PREP programming, 60% of high school aged participants who decided not to abstain from sex, indicated they would be more likely to use a condom. 51% indicated they would be more likely to use some form of birth control other than condoms.



After the program, survey data indicates that over 72% of students are more or much more likely to plan to graduate high school or receive a GED. Over 73% reported being more likely to care about doing well in school.



Looking to the Future



72% of participants responded that they are more likely to plan to get a steady full-time job after graduating.



71% of participants said they planned to get more education beyond high school.

Goal Setting and Planning



74% of students are more likely to make plans to reach their goals.



70% of students are more likely to understand the costs associated with raising a child.



59% of students are feeling more confident about how to prepare a budget.
